**Mission Youth, J&K through the Office of CEO, Mission Youth, J&K** invites online applications from eligible and interested FEMALE candidates from meritorious students belonging to the underprivileged section of society for applying to the scheme Super 75 to avail of the benefits of the scheme.

**CANDIDATES ARE ALSO ADVISED TO APPLY FOR THE FAMILY INCOME CERTIFICATE IMMEDIATELY TO ENSURE THAT THEY ARE ISSUED SAME WELL IN TIME**

The primary objective of the Scheme is to provide scholarships to meritorious candidates from marginalized sections of society for the following programs:

1. All post-graduate courses (regular courses).
2. Research Programs (Ph.D.)(regular courses)

The details regarding the merit calculation can be seen at **Point (3)** of this notification. General terms and conditions regarding the Selection Process, Eligibility, Educational Qualification, and Domicile, are as follows:

**(1) Eligibility:**

**a. Age Limit (as on 01.01.2023)**

The scholarship would be given only to students not more than 30 years as on 01.01.2023

**b. Qualification Criteria**

Only newly admitted first-year students pursuing regular course master's Programs or Ph.D. are eligible for the scholarship.

1. For postgraduate scholarships, the candidate must have scored a minimum 50% or equivalent grade at the undergraduate in subjects including Chemical Science, Earth Science, Life Science, Physical Science, Applied Science, Social Science Humanities, or any equivalent course.
2. For the Research Program scholarships, the candidate must have scored a minimum 60% or an equivalent grade at the post-graduate level in the relevant subject. Ph.D. Candidates availing NET-JRF/Inspire/WOS-A or any other fellowship for Ph.D. are not eligible under this scheme.

**c. Family Income**

Candidates are required to submit a copy/detail of the Income certificate issued by the competent authority during the application process. The income criteria are as follows:

1. Only the candidates having total family income from all sources not exceeding ₹1.00 lakh per annum shall be eligible for scholarship under the scheme. The candidate must possess a digitally signed Family Income Certificate (original scanned copy to be uploaded) issued by the Competent Authority (Tehsildar) in the format prescribed for the purpose. The income certificate must have been issued **on or after 01.06.2023**. No alternate document shall be accepted in place of Income Certificate and submission of any such document shall lead to rejection of application.
2. The above income criterion is not applicable to candidates belonging to the Person with Disability (PwD) category with a disability greater than 40%.

#### **d. Domicile**

##### **Candidate should be a Domicile of the Union Territory of Jammu & Kashmir**

as defined in terms of the Notifications issued by the Ministry of Home Affairs, Government of India vide S.O 1229 (E) dated 31-03-2020 and S.O 1245(E) dated 03-04-2020 read with the notification issued by the General Administration Department, Government of Jammu and Kashmir vide S.O 166 dated 18-05-2020.

Candidate must possess a Domicile Certificate issued by the Competent Authority in the format prescribed for the purpose, at the time of application submission.

#### **(2) Reserved Category:**

10% of slots are reserved for candidates who have lost a father/earning family member due to an insurgency-related event, and 04% slots are reserved for candidates with a disability greater than 40%. An additional 04 slots shall be reserved for special cases, to be nominated by the Hon'ble Lieutenant Governor, Jammu and Kashmir. In case of a shortfall in recommendations/reserved category candidates, the reserved slots shall be diverted to the open category.

#### **(3) Procedure of Selection:**

The following structure shall be used to calculate the merit of the candidates:

##### **a) For Post-Graduate Course:**

1. The calculation of merit shall be based on a three-tier assessment as follows:
  - a. (S1)- Undergraduate percentage
    - i. pro-rata basis – 60 pts
  - b. (S2)-Entrance Score
    - i. Pro-rata basis- 30 pts
  - c. (S3)- Entrance Rank
    - i. Rank 1- 10 pts
    - ii. Rank 2- 5 pts
    - iii. Rank 3- 2.5 pts
2. In case of equal score, preference merit shall be decided on the basis of higher undergraduate percentage and entrance percentage – in this order of preference.
3. In case of candidates selected based on entrance but the entrance is of qualifying nature with no merit list released. The candidate shall be awarded score based on cut-off marks in the entrance subject to submission of university certified cut-off marks by the candidate.

**b) For Ph.D. Course:**

1. The calculation of merit shall be based on a three-tier assessment as follows:
  - a. (S1)- UG Score – 15 pts (Pro- rata basis)
  - b. (S2)- PG Score - 50 pts (Pro-rata basis)
  - c. (S3) – NET/GATE Qualified – 15 pts
  - d. (S4) – M.Phil – 05 pts
  - e. (S5)- Direct Selection/ Entrance
    - i. Direct Selection w/o Entrance (15 pts)
    - ii. Entrance based selection
      - Entrance Score 10 pts on pro rata basis
      - Rank in Entrance (1<sup>st</sup> -5 pts, 2<sup>nd</sup> -2.5pts)
2. In case of equal score, preference merit shall be decided on the basis of higher post-graduate percentage and UG percentage- in this order of preference.
3. In case of candidates selected based on entrance but the entrance is of qualifying nature with no merit list released. The candidate shall be awarded score based on cut-off marks in the entrance subject to submission of university certified cut-off marks by the candidate.

**(4) Process of disbursement:**

Irrespective of duration of the course, the scholarship shall be given for a period of two years only in two installments are as follow:

1. **Before the release of 1<sup>st</sup> instalment:**The first installment of scholarship i.e. INR 0.50 lakh shall be given to the selected student in her first year/ first year of her program at the beginning of the academic year. Before the release of the 1<sup>st</sup> installment, the candidate shall be asked to submit an undertaking at the time of document verification that:
  - a. The candidate shall not avail the benefit of any other scholarship scheme (Govt. /private funded) scholarship scheme besides uploading this data in the public domain on the official website.
  - b. The candidate has not availed any benefit of scholarship at the time of application for the scheme.

The release of first installment of scholarship shall be subject to production of original documents mentioned in the scheme guideline before the screening committee of Mission Youth.

2. **Before the release of 2<sup>nd</sup> Instalment:** The second installment of scholarship shall be released after the successful compilation of first 2 semesters/ first year of the course, subject to production of original documents as mentioned in the scheme guideline. Also, before the release of 2<sup>nd</sup> installment, a verification report may be sought from:

- a. Deputy Commissioner wherein it may be ascertained that the candidate has not availed scholarship from DSWO office/ALC office
- b. HOD of department of University that the candidate has not availed any scholarship/fellowship for the course.

**THE AMOUNT OF THE SECOND INSTALLMENT SHALL BE ADJUSTED SO THAT THE AGGREGATE SCHOLARSHIP MAY NOT EXCEED 2 TIMES THE ACTUAL EXPENDITURE INCURRED BY THE CANDIDATE DURING THE FIRST YEAR OR INR 1.00 LAKH, WHICHEVER IS MINIMUM.**

**(5) How to Apply:**

To apply under the Super 75 scheme, the candidate must visit the Mission Youth online portal. The candidates shall click on the **Apply for Super 75 Scheme** banner on the portal. The candidate shall fill up the Super 75 application form, upload a recent photograph, give an undertaking, and submit the application form.

**Candidates are advised to fill in all the details in the form very carefully to avoid mistakes/ errors.**
