- ii) A Master's Degree with at least 55% marks in any branch of Agriculture & allied Sciences (or an equivalent grade in OGPA/ a point-scale wherever the grading system is followed).
- iii) A minimum of eight years of experience of teaching and/or research and/or extension in an academic / research / extension position equivalent to that of Assistant Professor/Jr. Scientist in a University, College or Accredited Research Institution/ Industry with a minimum of seven (07) publications in the NAAS rated or Peer-reviewed or UGC-listed journals and a total research score of Seventy five (75) as per the criteria given in the Annexure to this Notification.

Note: Academic / Research / Extension Score obtained as per the Annexure to this Notification, shall have a weightage of 80/100 marks (80%) and 20/100 marks (20%) shall be for interview before the prescribed Selection Committee.





Peer-Reviewed or NAAS rated or UGC-listed Journals (Impact factor to be determined as per Thomson Reuters list):

a.	Paper in refereed journals without impact factor	= 5 Points
b.	Paper with impact factor less than 1	= 10 Points
c.	Paper with impact factor between 1 and 2	= 15 Points
d.	Paper with impact factor between 2 and 5	= 20 Points
e.	Paper with impact factor between 5 and 10	=25 Points
f.	Paper with impact factor >10	= 30 Points

- i. Two authors: 70% of total value of publication for each author.
- ii. More than two authors: 70% of total value of publication for the First/Principal/Corresponding author and 30% of total value of publication for each of the joint authors.
- 2. Joint Projects: Principal Investigator and Co-investigator would get 50% each.
- 3. Paper presented if part of edited book or proceeding then it can be claimed only once.
- 4. For joint supervision of research students, the formula shall be 70% of the total score for major advisor and 30% of the total score advisory committee members.
- 5. *For the purpose of calculating research score of the teacher, the combined research score from the categories of 5(b). Policy Document and 6. Invited lectures/Resource Person/Paper presentation shall have an upper capping of thirty percent (30%) of the total research score of the teacher concerned.
- 6. The research & extension score shall be from the minimum of three categories out of seven categories (categories 1 to 7).
- 7. The extension score shall be from the minimum of three categories out of seven categories (categories 1 to 7). Category 7 is the compulsory category for the scientists working in extension system of the university
- 8. Academic/Research/Extension Score = 100
- 9. Academic /research /extension score will have a weightage of 80% (80/100) and interview a weightage of 20% (20/100)
