## **Fundamental Duties**

The Fundamental Duties are eleven in number, incorporated in Art. 51A [Part IVA], which has been incorporated by the 42nd Amendment Act, 1976.

## Under this Article, it is the duty of every citizen of India :

**1.** to abide by the Constitution and respect its ideals and institutions, the National Flag and the National Anthem;

**2.** to cherish and follow the noble ideals which inspired our National St uggl for freedom;

**3.** to uphold and protect the sovereignty, unity and integrity of ndia;

**4.** to defend the country;

**5.** to promote harmony and the spirit of common b therho d amongst all the people of India;

6. to value and preserve the rich heritage four composit culture;

7. to protect and improve the natural envi nment;

8. to develop the scientific m er and irit of inquiry;

9. to safeguard public pro erty;

**10.** to strive towards xcellence n all spheres of individual and collective activity.

**11.** to p ovide portuni s f education to his child or ward as the case may be between th age of six and fourteen years.

**Note :** e 11th Fundamental Duty was added by the 86th Constitutional Amendment Act, 2002.

There is no proise ion in the Constitution for direct enforcement of any of the Fundamental Dut is nor for any sanction to prevent their violation.
