Different Sources of the Indian Constitution

Although the skeleton of the constitution was derived from the Government of India Act 1935, many provisions were imported from other constitutions of the world. Some of them are listed below along with the Government of India Act, 1935 :

Government of India Act, 1935 :This Act formed the basis or 'blueprint' of the constitution of India with the features of Federal system, office of Governor, emergency powers etc. Besides, the Constitution of India has borrowed from the—

Constitution of Britain : Law making procedures, Rule of law, Single tize hip, i-cameral Parliamentary system, office of CAG.

Constitution of USA : Independence of judiciary, judicial revi w, fund mental rights, removal of Supreme Court and High Court judges, Preamb e an functions of President and Vice-president.

Constitution of Canada : Federation with strong e, to p ovide residuary powers to the Centre, Supreme Court's advisory jurisdicti n.

Constitution of Ireland : Directive Prin ples o State po icy, method of presidential elections, and the nomination of membe to Rajya S ha by the President.

Weimar Constitution of Germ ny : Provisi s concerning the suspension of fundamental rights during em rgency.

Constitution of Austra ia Idea, f the Concurrent List, Trade and Commerce provisions.

Constitution of South frica : Amendment with 2/3rd majority in Parliament and election f the Members of Rajya Sabha on the basis of proportional representation.

Consti tion o France : Republican System, / Principles of Liberty, Equality and Fraternity

Constitution o former USSR : Fundamental Duties, Ideals of justice in Preamble.
